Fritz G. Wallner is born in 1945 in Weiten, Austria. He studied a couple of disciplines (Philosophy, Psychology, German and classical literatures, education). After some years as a highschool-techer, reader at the Department of Theoretical Physics and university docent (Senior lecturer) he became 1987 Professor for Philosophy and Philosophy of Science at Vienna University.

During 1985-95 Development of a new Philosophy of Science (Constructive Realism), which makes the manifold scientific approaches depending from different cultures understandable.

Since 1990 intensive work on the argumentative structure of TCM.
